

Students are permitted to use University motor vehicles under the following conditions:

- Through Promaster a Travel Plan is submitted and authorised by a Head of School or researcher with authority to expend research funds.
- The allocation of a vehicle to a student will only occur once official teaching and administrative purposes have been met.
- The student driving the vehicle must possess a current and valid Australian driver's licence, or in special cases, other approved driver's licence.
- The vehicle can only be driven by the student authorised on the Travel Plan.
- The vehicle is to be allocated for a specific journey only and must be collected and returned to Fleet on the times specified on the Travel Plan. Only in special circumstances are students permitted to retain a vehicle overnight.
